The PSAT 10 will also connect students to access to more than \$220 million annually in scholarships to qualified students from one of the largest scholarship provider pools in the country.

In addition to all of these benefits, the PSAT 10 will also become our primary benchmark for choosing which students will qualify for the Advanced classes beginning in 11th Grade.

The cost of the PSAT 10 will be \$16.00. Money is due to the Financial Office on or before February 16th.
