Scholarship Opportunities / Discounted Rates

- Federal financial aid is not available to students who have not yet graduated HS
- MBU provides a 50% tuition discount for college courses taken online

Courses

- Regionally accredited, enabling credits to be transferred as any well-known university; students should always check with the receiving institution to ensure MBU coursework meets specific requirements
- Only \$175 per credit hour = a 60% tuition discount
- Online courses, with flexible deadlines, no mandatory meeting times, are available along with virtual courses
- Courses available towards Associate or Baccalaureate degree

- Approval from HS guidance counselor / administrator

Eligibility

- High school juniors and seniors; rising juniors may begin the summer after sophomore year)
- Approval from HS guidance counselor / administrator

- Online application (free)
- No HS transcripts required | No minimum GPA requirement
- Submit a screenshot of ACT or SAT scores to the registrar if registering for 100-level English and/or Math course; then request official scores be sent to BJU; if an ACT or SAT score is not available, a placement test can be taken through the university at not cost to the student

- HS Transcript

- Online application to be admitted

- High School Transcript; if transcript is not available, minimum test scores are required from any of the following: ACT, SAT, CLT, ACT OnCampus, and select ACCUPLACER

- Career and Technical Education (CTE) available for specific CTE programs
- Recipients of the fully-funded PACT Program may apply those funds towards Dual Enrollment

Courses

- Refer to the current course schedule or consult with the Dual Enrollment Coordinator
- Course offerings at selected high schools in the area; online classes are an option in some cases

Eligibility

- High school sophomores, juniors, and seniors
- Unweighted 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale
- Approval from HS guidance counselor / administrator
- Continuous Eligibility: must meet a minimum grade requirement of a C or higher; students who fail to do this or who withdraw from a course will be suspended from the program for a minimum of one term (not to be served during summer); for re-entry, the student must reapply and meet the minimum 2.5 GPA requirement

- Online application to be admitted
- Submit Accuplacer scores or comparable ACT scores if registering for English and/or Math; minimum ACT scores: 18 in English | 20 in Math & Reading

Eligibility

- High school sophomores, juniors, and seniors
- Unweighted 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale
- Approval from HS guidance counselor / administrator

- Online application (free and for new students only) to be admitted
- Present copy of unexpired ID (e.g., driver's license or permit)
- Submit official HS transcript reflecting GPA
- Submit ACT or Accuplacer scores (if registering for an English and/or Math)
- Submit completed signature page to dual enrollment office to register for classes
